1 Name, Scope and Level of the Course

The course is provided by the University of Skövde and is named Swedish for International Students - Intensive Course G1N. It comprises 6 credits and is on Basic level, the level of progression of the course is G1N.

2 Objectives

After completed course the student should be able to:

- Use common words and phrases in contexts of family, shopping, studies and personal interests
- Read simple texts such as timetables, advertisements and short messages
- Write simple texts such as short messages and personal letters and
- Account for basic aspects of pronunciation and basic grammatical rules, such as noun and verb inflection and word order.

3 Course Content

This intensive course provides students with a basic knowledge in Swedish language and culture and is designed for international students. The course gives basis skills in both oral and written Swedish. Content include knowledge of Swedish structure, vocabulary and familiar everyday expressions. The course also includes areas related to Swedish culture and society, including excursions, as well as introduction to Swedish university. The course will provide a good basis for further studies in Swedish language.

4 Teaching

The teaching comprises lectures, seminars/group discussions and exercises.

The teaching is normally conducted in Swedish, but can occasionally be in English.

5 Examination

The course is graded Fail (U) or Pass (G).

The grade is translated to the ECTS grading scale (A, B, C, D, E, Fx or F).
